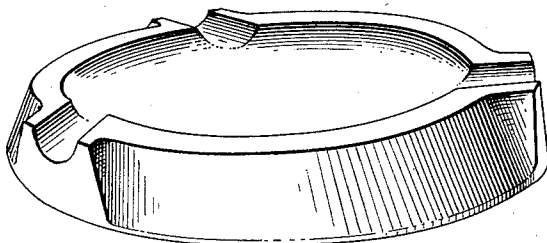
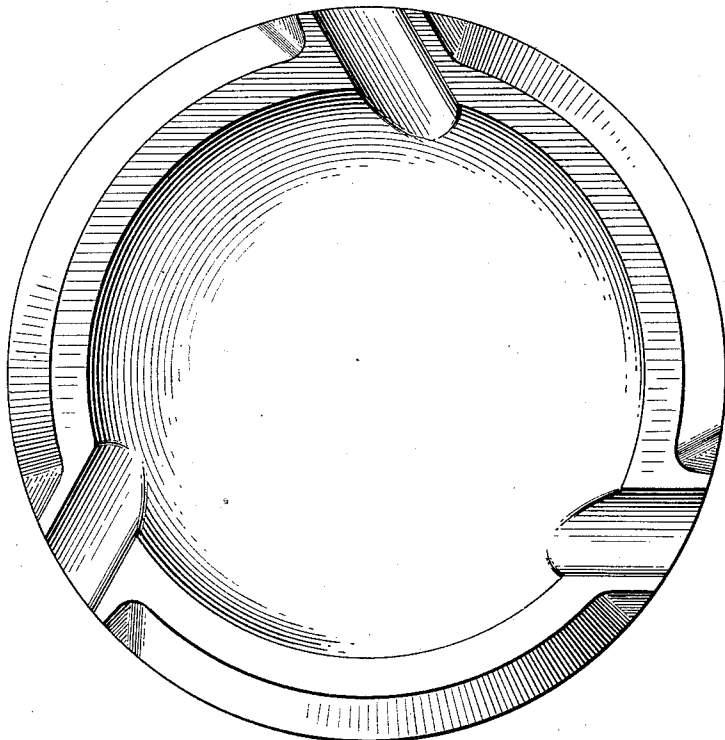

Be it known that I, JOHN H.
