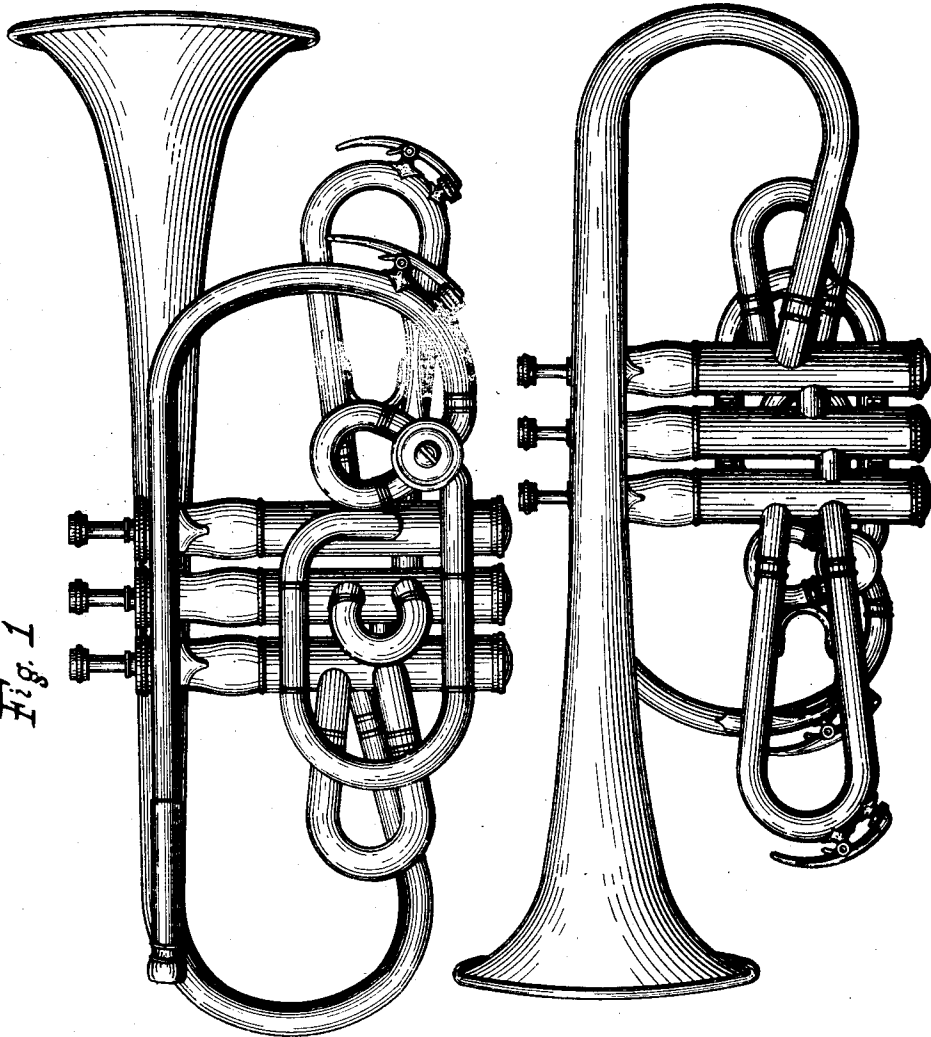

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ERNST A. COUTURIER, a citizen of the United States, residing at Elkhart, in the county of Elkhart and State of Indiana, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Cornets, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is an elevation of the obverse side of a cornet embodying my new design; and
