

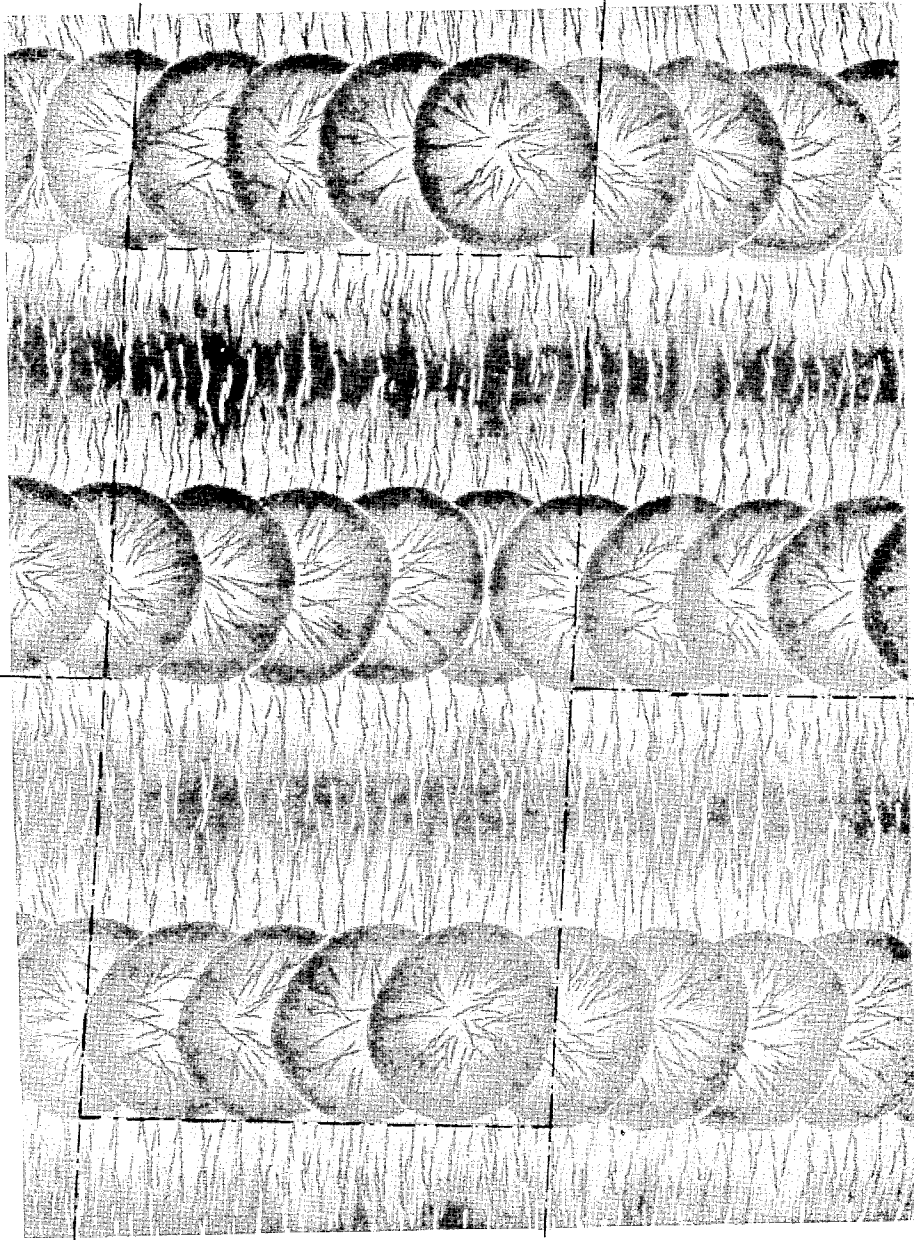

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Ben Leerer, a citizen of the United States of America, residing in New York, county of New York, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Textile Fabric, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The figure on the drawing is a plan view of a textile fabric, showing my new design.

A design unit is outlined by broken lines and is repeated as indicated.
