

DESIGN FOR A DRESS

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Mark Cohn, a citizen of the United States, residing in New York city, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Dress, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a front view of a dress showing my new design; and

Fig. 2 is a rear view thereof.

The characteristic feature of my design resides in the combination of the dress disclosed of the specific embroidered lace panels and yokes in front and back in association with the particular sleeves, as shown.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a dress, substantially as shown and described.
