



To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Jean E. Vivaudou, a subject of the King of Great Britain, residing at New York, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Herb Bag, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

In the drawing:

Fig. 1 is a top plan view of a herb bag, showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a bottom plan view; and

Fig. 3 is a side elevational view of the same.
