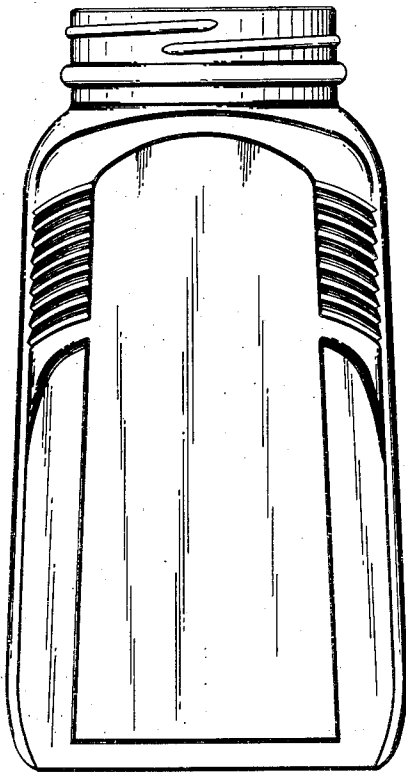

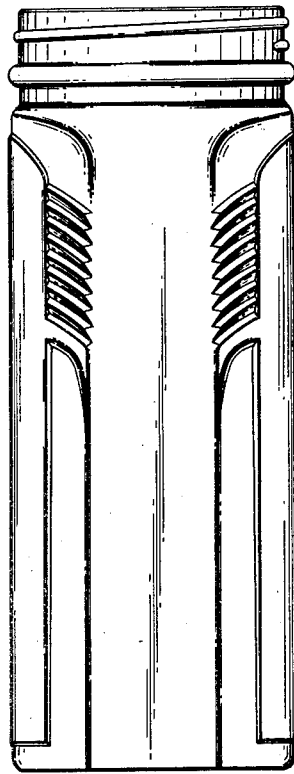

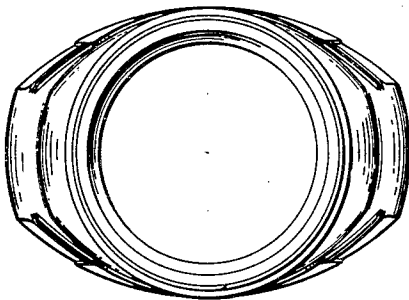

To whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Olbert C. Noble, a citizen of the United States, residing at Washington, in the county of Washington, State of Pennsylvania, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Jar, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing forming a part thereof.
