



## DESIGN FOR A CHAIR

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Dwight Powell, a citizen of the United States, residing at Youngstown, in the county of Mahoning and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Chair, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The figure is a perspective view of a chair showing my new design.

The essential features of the design reside in

the combination of the chair body and base as shown, the base comprising a unitary member having radiating legs with substantially vertical, square end portions the upper surfaces of which are provided with rectangular grid-like scuff plates, as shown.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a chair, as shown and described.
