DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a purse mirror
showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, as seen from
the right side in FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is an end elevational view thereof, as seen from
the top in FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is another side elevational view thereof, as seen
from the left side in FIG. 1; and,
FIG. 6 is another end elevational view thereof, as seen
from the bottom in FIG. 1.

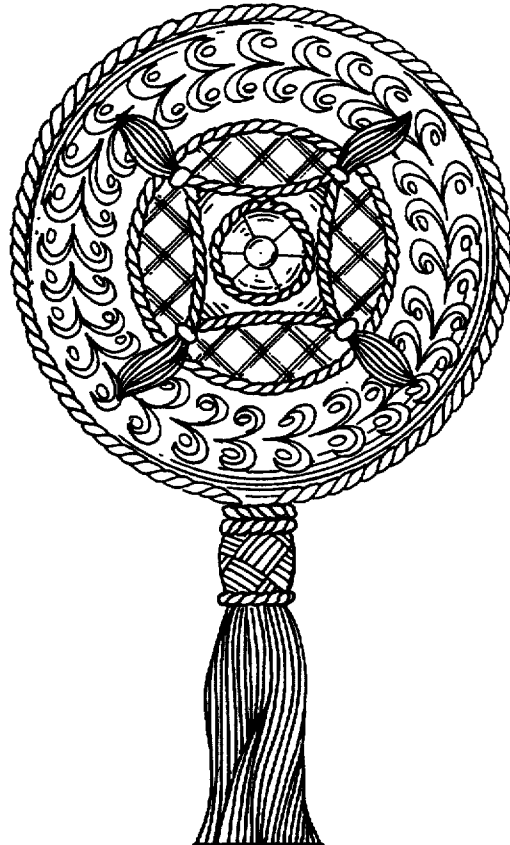
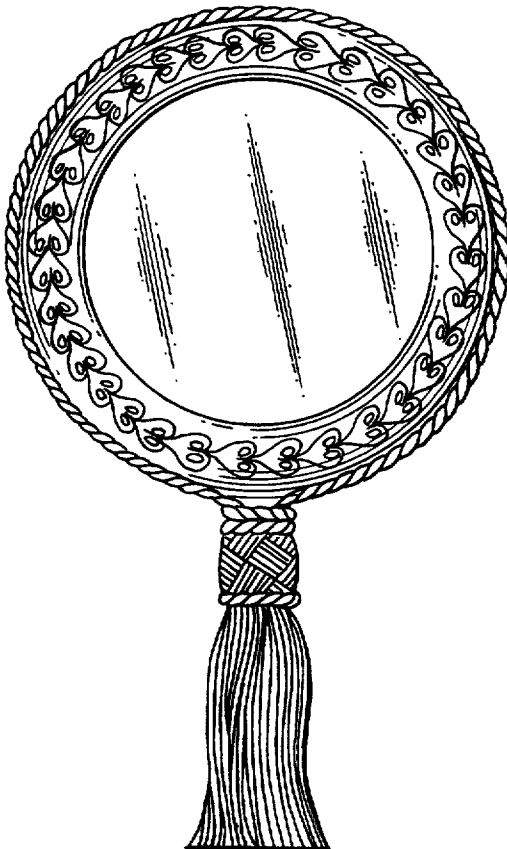

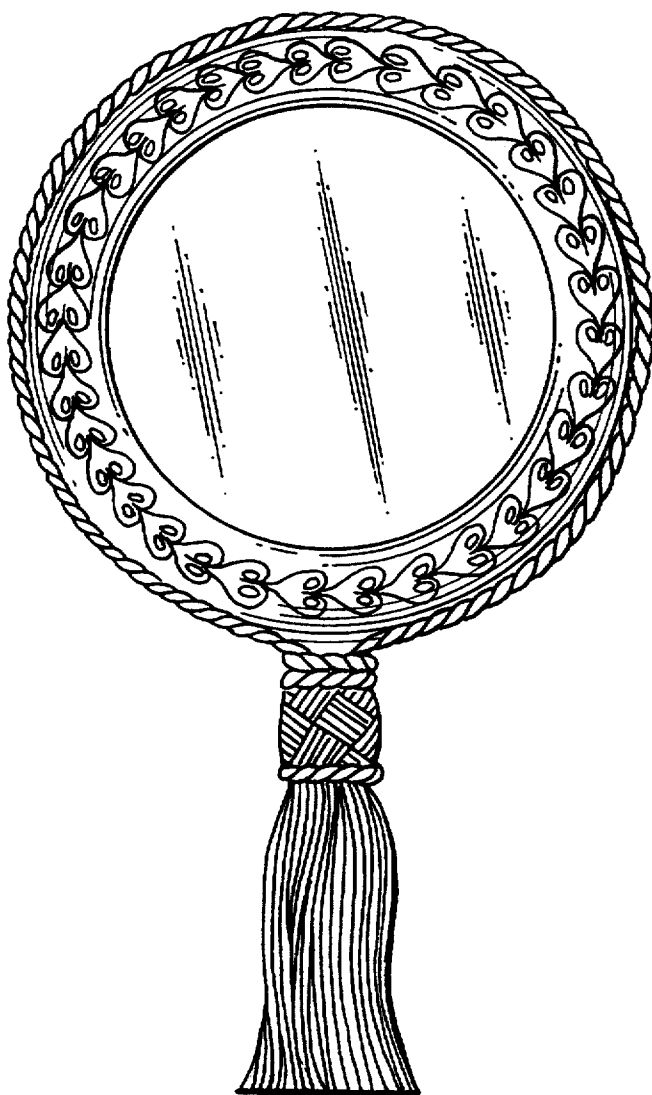

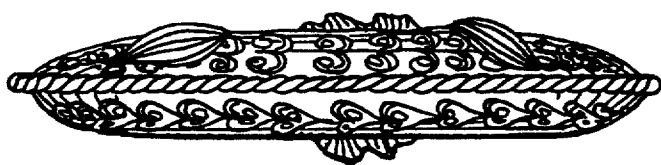
