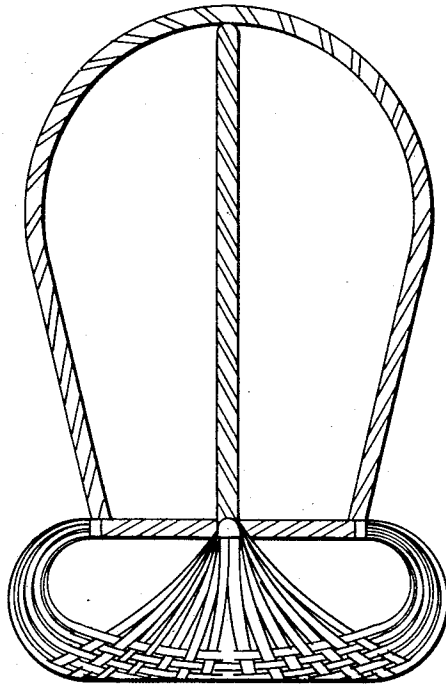

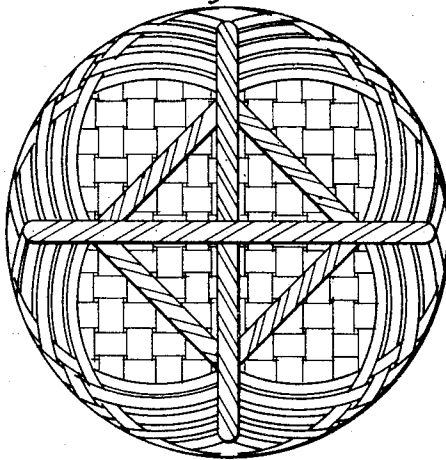

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, BESSIE M. CHESTER, a citizen of the United States, residing at Longbeach, in the county of Los Angeles and State of California, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Woven Palm-Leaf Baskets, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.
