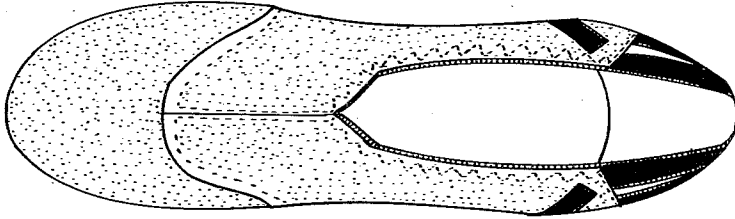

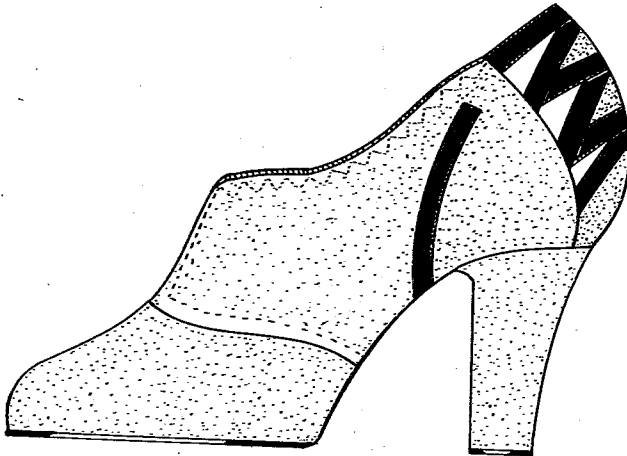
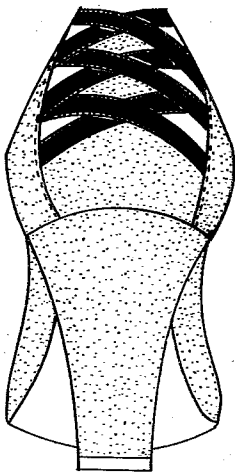

DESIGN FOR A SHOE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Andrew Geller, a citizen of the United States and resident of New York city, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Shoe, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, in which:

Fig. 1 is a plan view of the shoe showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a side view of the shoe, shown in Fig. 1; and

Fig. 3 is a rear view of the shoe shown in Fig. 1.
