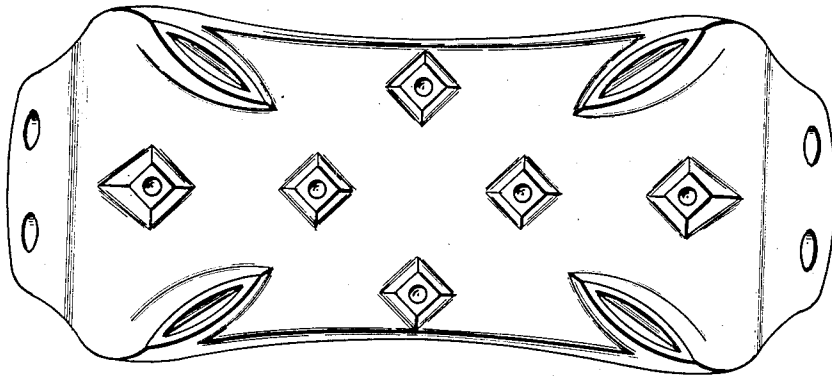

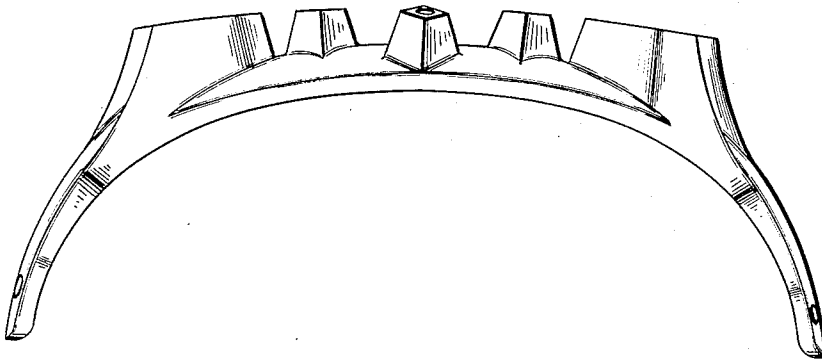
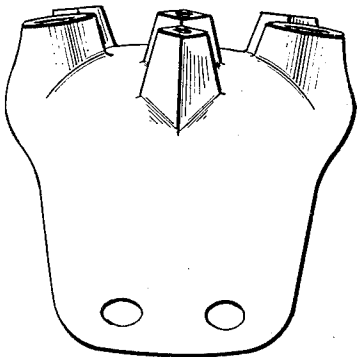

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Emile Lafond, a citizen of the United States, residing at Lewiston, in the county of Androscoggin and State of Maine, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for an Antiskid Device, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof,
