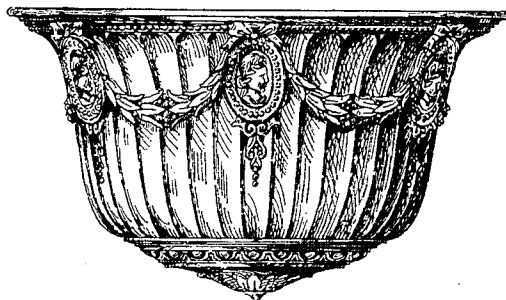

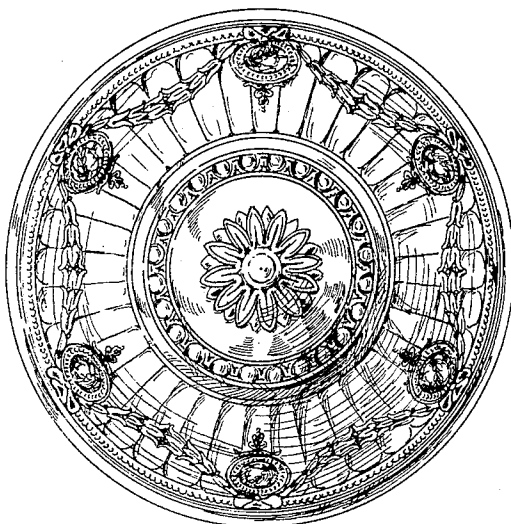

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, MAX SCHAFFER, a citizen of the United States, residing at 2116 Vyse avenue, borough of Bronx, county of Bronx, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental design for Glass Bowls, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 shows side elevation of glass bowl embodying my invention, Fig. 2 shows a plan view.
