DESIGN FOR A CARPET.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 15,693, dated January 6, 1885.

Application filed November 28, 1884. Term of patent 3½ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, EDWIN FISHER, of the
city of Boston, county of Suffolk, and State of
Massachusetts, have invented and produced a
5 new and original Design for a Pattern to be
Inwrought in Two or Three Ply Ingrain and
other Carpeting, in such colors as may be de-
sired; and I do hereby declare that the pho-
tographic print accompanying this specifica-
10 tion conveys to any one skilled in the art of
carpet-weaving a clear understanding of the
same, and is sufficient to enable such person
to use my invention.

What I claim as my invention, and desire to
secure by Letters Patent, is— 15
The design for ingrain or other carpeting,
consisting in the ornamentation shown in the
photographic print accompanying this speci-
fication.
