





## DESIGN FOR A COMBINED RADIATOR SHELL AND DEFLECTOR

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, Benjamin Kirsch and Albert Benjamin Medville, citizens of the United States and residents of Chicago, Cook County, Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Combined Radiator Shell and Deflector, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof, in which

Fig. 1 is a plan view of the combined radiator and deflector showing our new design;

Fig. 2 is a front elevation of Fig. 1;

Fig. 3 is a right side elevation of Fig. 1; and,

Fig. 4 is a view similar to Fig. 2 showing the appearance of the device under an alternative adjustment.

We claim:

The ornamental design for a combined radiator shell and deflector, substantially as shown and described.
