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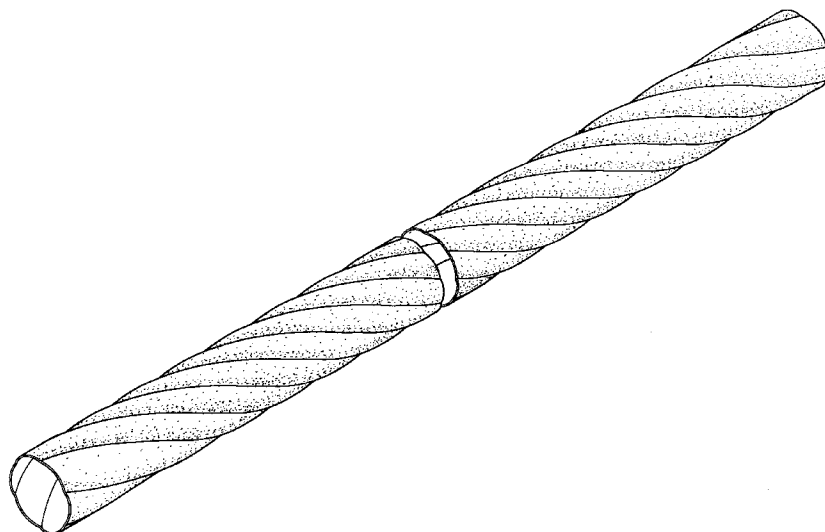
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of one embodiment of a tubular part for furniture showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the tubular part for furniture of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the tubular part for furniture of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view of the tubular part for furniture of FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view of the tubular part for furniture of FIG. 1;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the tubular part for furniture of FIG. 1; and,
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the tubular part for furniture of FIG. 1.
FIGS. 1, 4, 5, 6 and 7 have been broken away to indicate indeterminate length.

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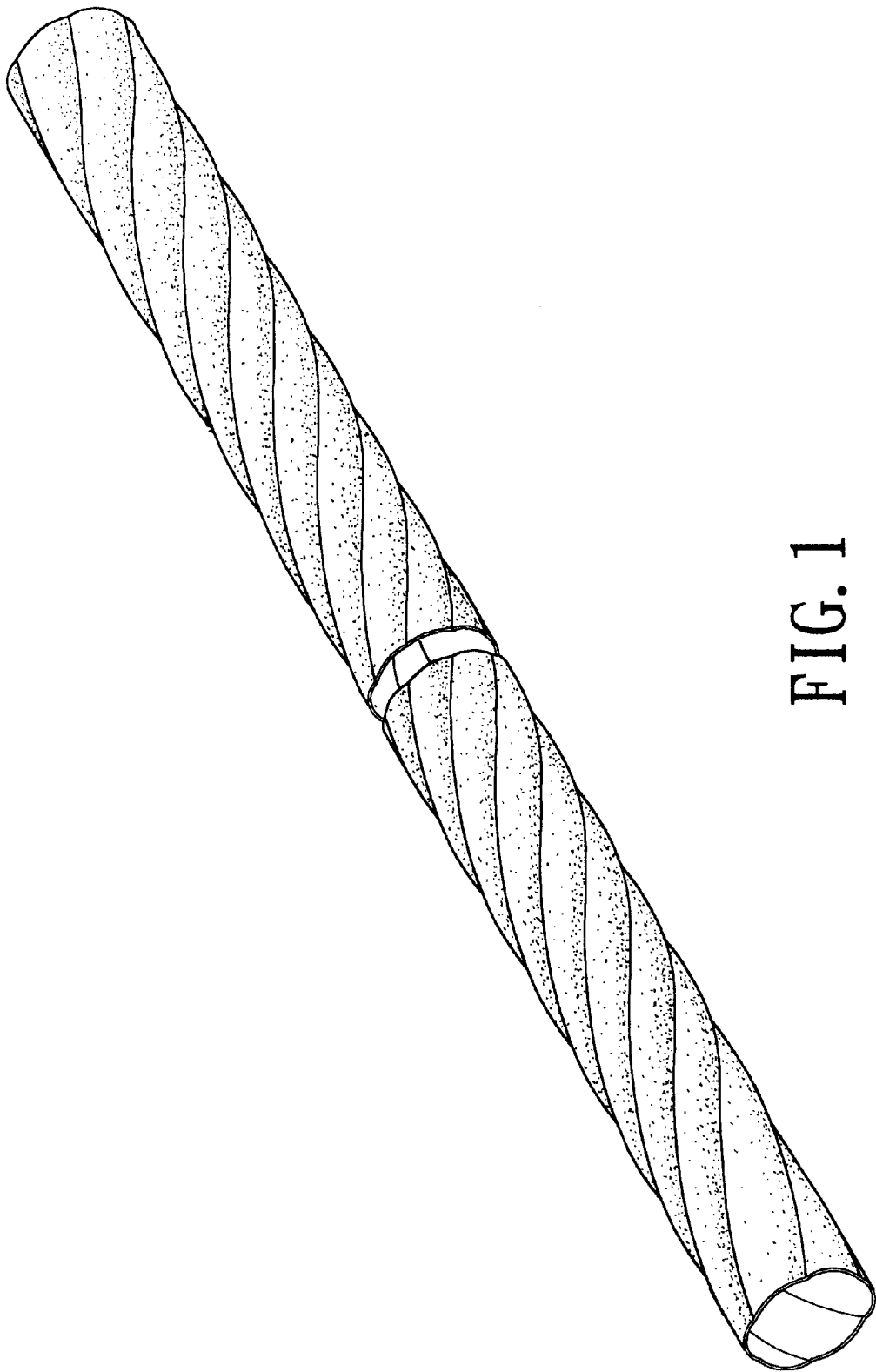

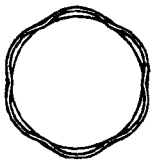

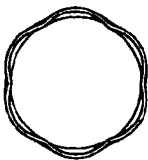

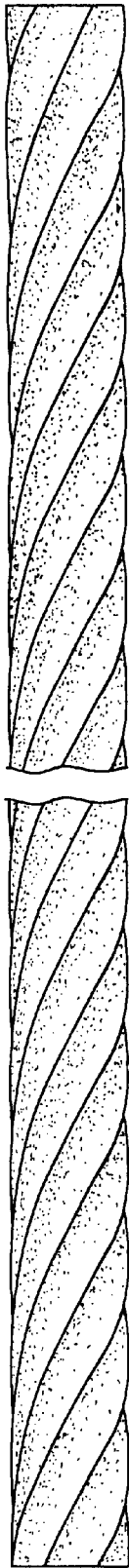

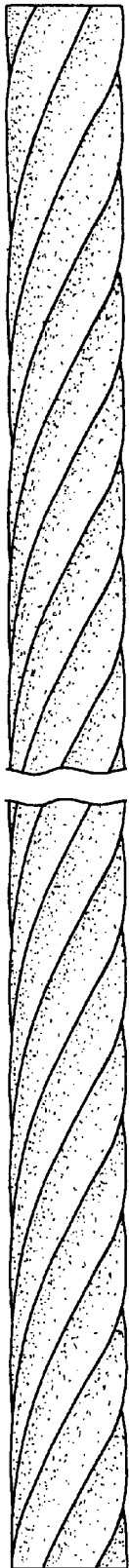

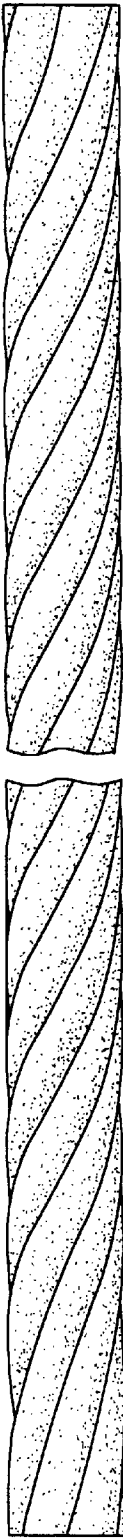

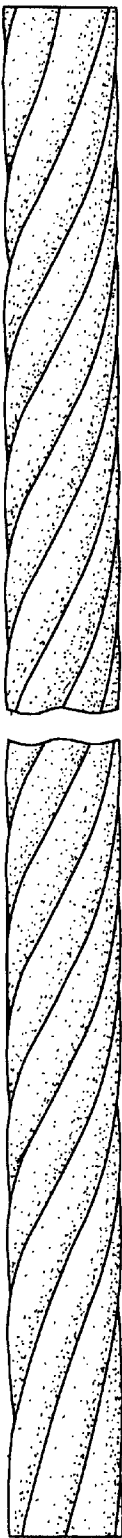
