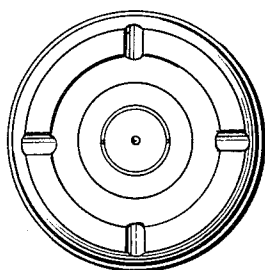
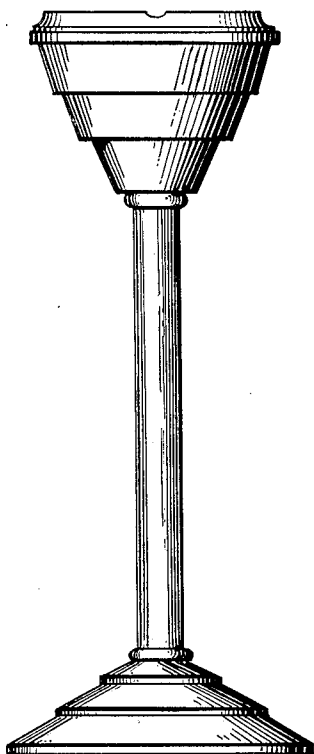

DESIGN FOR A SMOKING STAND

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JOHN S. KANDEL, a citizen of the United States, residing at 7659 Bosworth Avenue, in the city of Chicago, county of Cook, and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Smoking Stands, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a side elevation of a smoking stand showing my new design; and

Fig. 2 is a plan view of the top element of the design shown in Fig. 1.
