


Figure 1 is a perspective view of a furniture leg, showing my new design as seen from the outer corner thereof;

Fig. 2 is an elevational view of said leg;

Fig. 3 is an elevational view of the leg as seen from the outer corner thereof;

Fig. 4 is a top plan view of said leg;

Fig. 5 is an enlarged perspective detail of the upper end of said leg; and

Fig. 6 is a cross-sectional view taken through the leg along the line 6—6 of Fig. 3.

The dominant features of my design reside in that portion shown in full lines on the drawing.

The broken line showing of a fragmentary table top in Figure 1 is for illustrative purposes only.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a furniture leg substantially as shown and described.
