

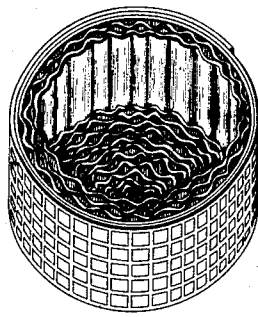

DESIGN FOR A CEREAL CUP.

Application filed May 3, 1921. Serial No. 466,615. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, SCOTT H. PERKY, a citizen of the United States, residing at Keeseville, in the county of Essex and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Cereal Cup, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The figure is a perspective view showing my new design for cereal cup, having a corrugated interior and bottom with a smoothly wrapped exterior.
