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(54) **Portable air-conditioning equipment**

(57) Portable air-conditioning equipment (1) which requires an unusually small space for its installation, comprises, in a casing (7), a grille (10) for the intake of air from the environment, a grille (12) for the output of cold air, a hot-air outlet (14) facing upwardly and a flexible tube (15) extending from the hot-air outlet (14) to a free end (17) intended to be associated with a window.

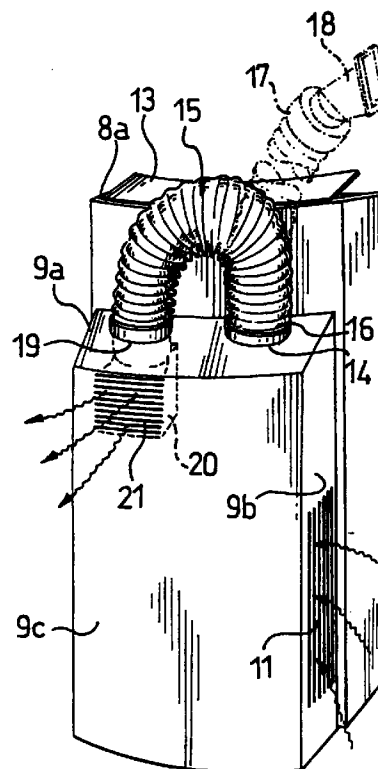
