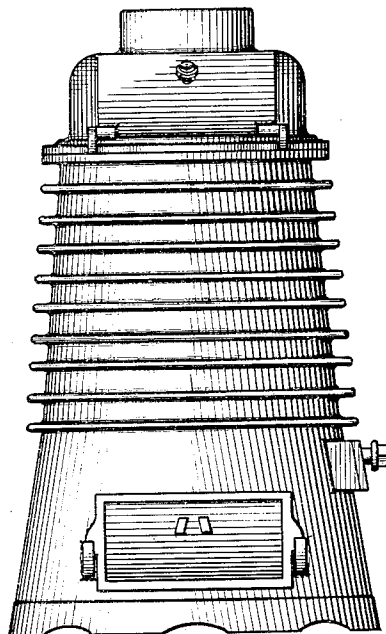

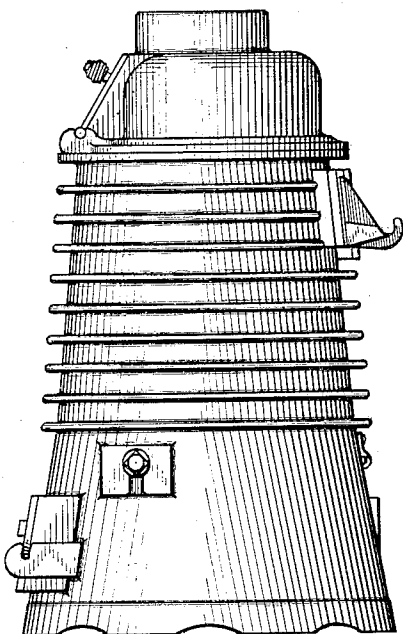
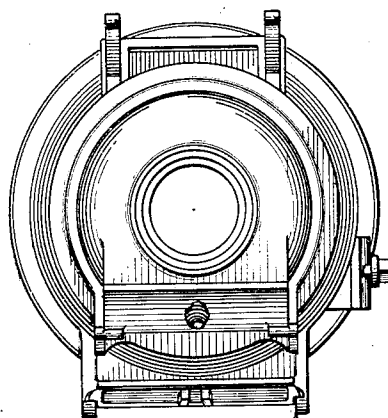

DESIGN FOR A BROODER STOVE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Leland G. Knapp, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Brooder Stove, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a front elevation of a brooder stove showing my new design;
