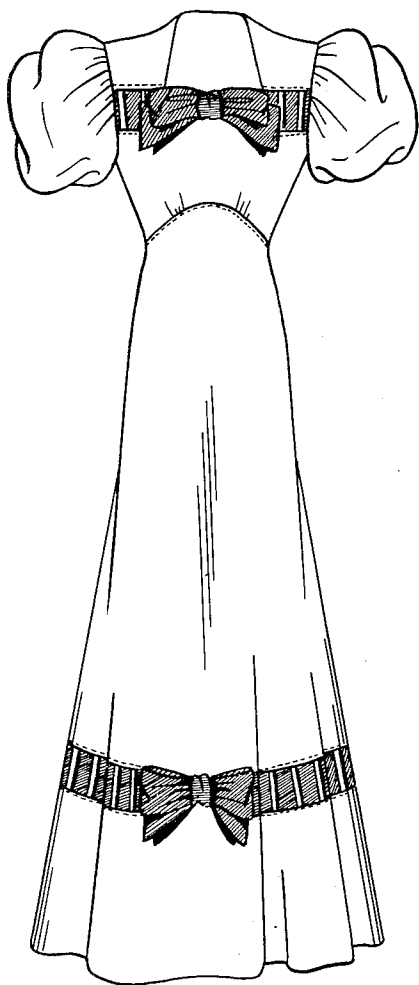

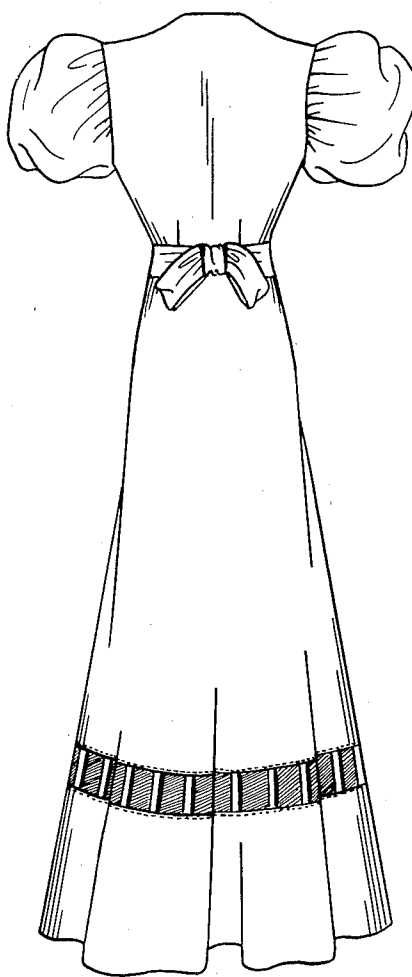

DESIGN FOR A DRESS

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Rose Feintuck, a citizen of the United States of America, residing in Manhattan, county and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Dress, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, wherein,

Figure 1 is a front view of a dress showing my new design.

Figure 2 is a rear view of the dress shown in Figure 1.

The design is characterized by contrasting lacings pulled through lattice work on the blouse and skirt portions of the dress, as shown.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a dress, substantially as shown, and described.
