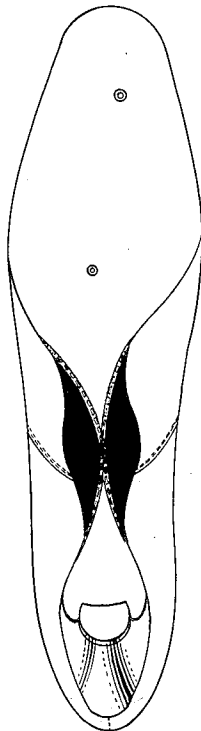
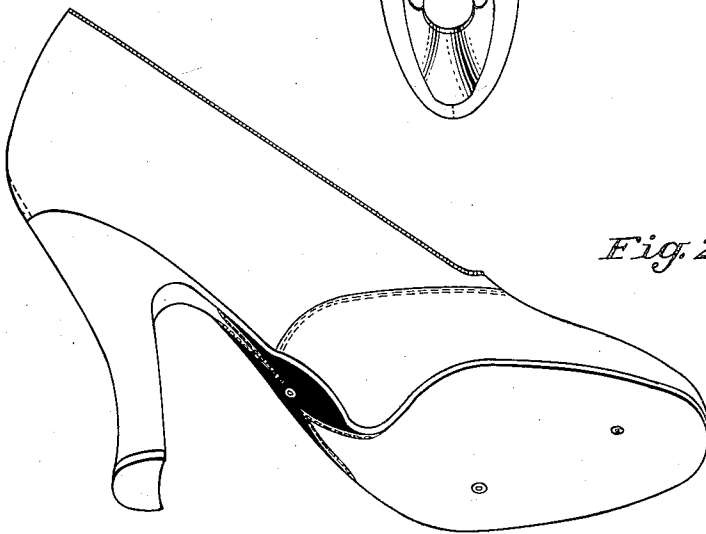

DESIGN FOR A SHOE OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Edmond Saugues, a citizen of the United States of America, residing in Woodhaven, L. I., county of Queens and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Shoe or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof,

Fig. 1 is a bottom plan view of a shoe showing

my new design, the shape of the shoe being conventional, and

Fig. 2 is a bottom perspective view of the same.

The breast of the heel and the sole verge to a center point on the shank which is divided into two parts forming my design.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a shoe or similar article substantially as shown and described.
