

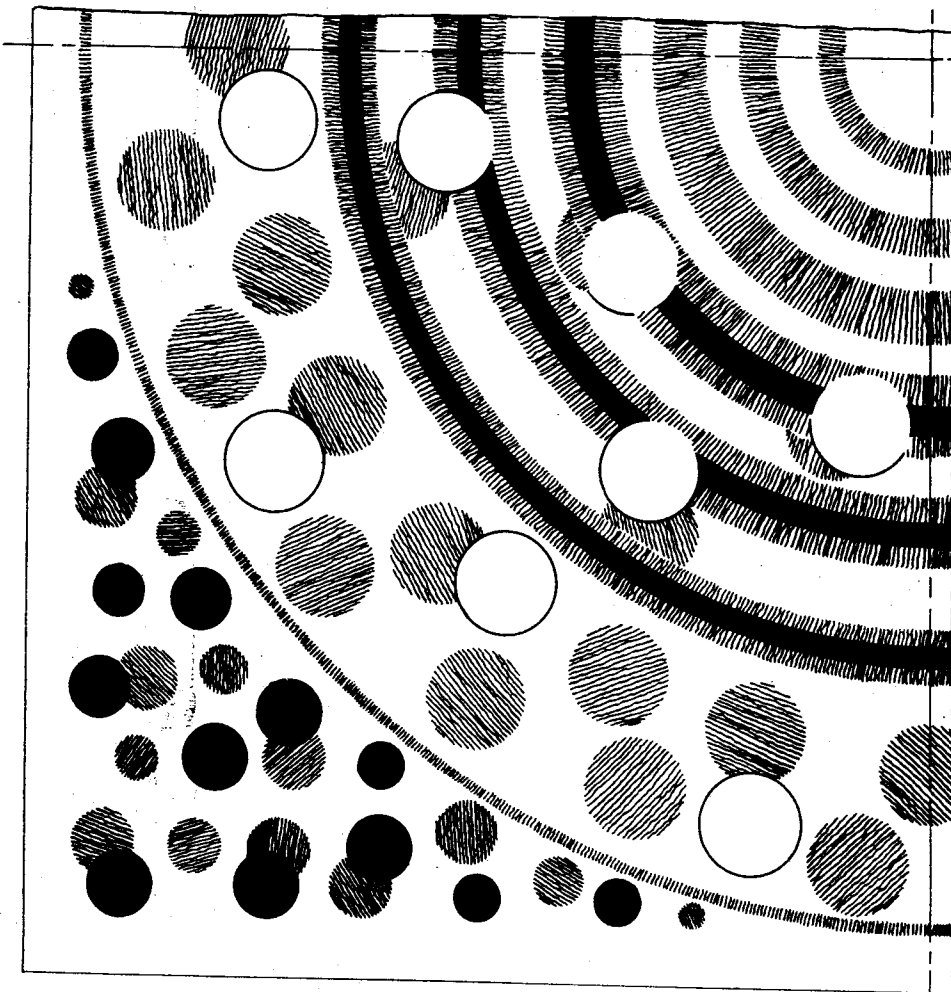

DESIGN FOR A TEXTILE FABRIC

Application filed November 30, 1932. Serial No. 46,198. Term of patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JEAN VAN DER DOES, a citizen of the United States, residing at the city of New York, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Textile Fabric, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The figure is a plan view of a textile fabric,

intended for a square scarf, showing my new design. A quarter section of my design is substantially comprised within the area defined by the indicating lines shown on the drawing.
