

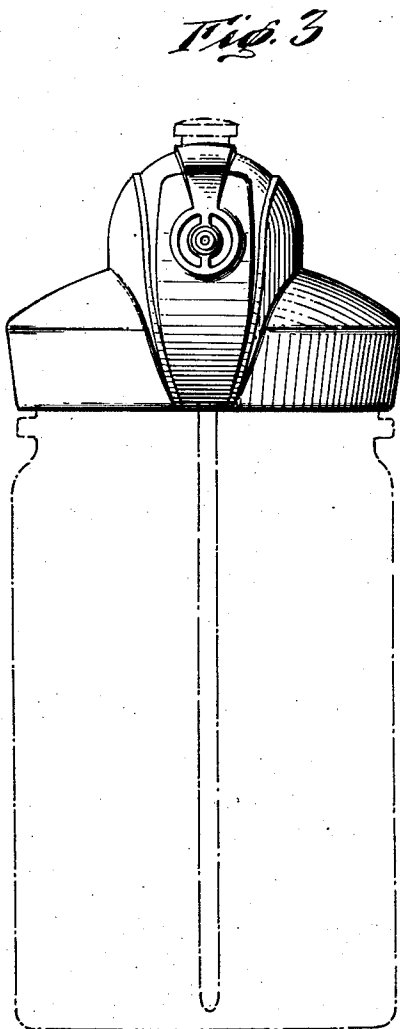
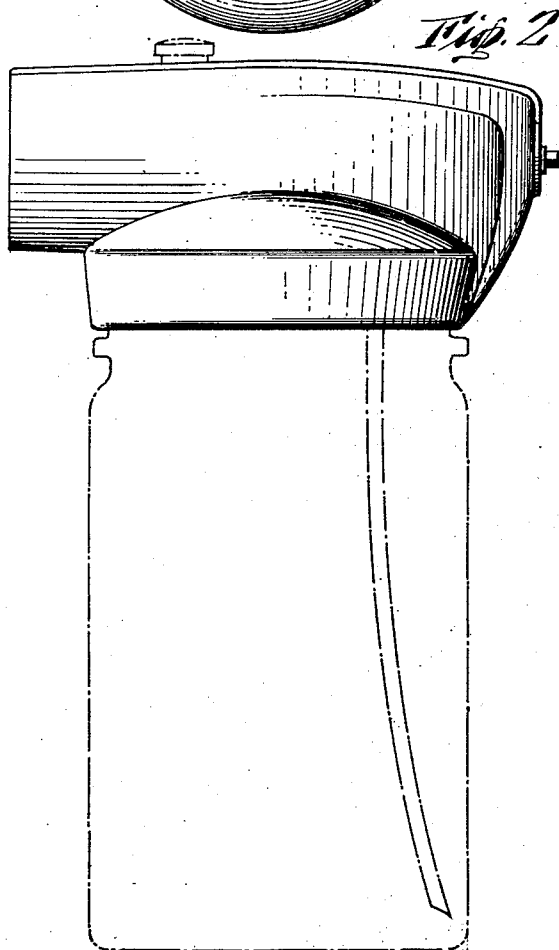
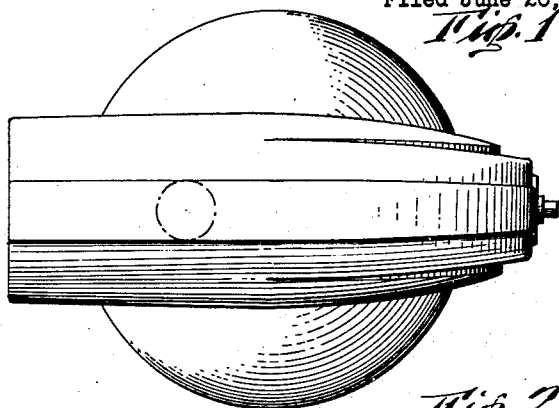

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Carl E. Meyerhoefer, a citizen of the United States, residing at Brooklyn, county of Kings, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Sprayer, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing forming a part thereof, wherein:

Fig. 1 is a top plan view of a sprayer showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a side elevation thereof; and

Fig. 3 is a front view of the same.

The dominant features of my new design reside in the portions shown in full lines.
