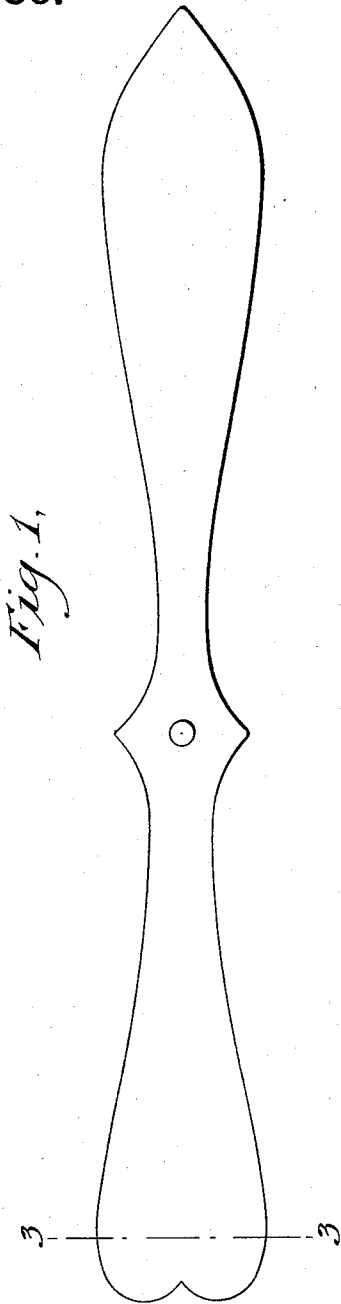

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ARTHUR W. COX, a citizen of the United States, and a resident of Malden, in the county of Middlesex and State of Massachusetts, United States of America, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Knife for Table Use and other Purposes, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a plan view of a knife embodying my new design; Fig. 2 is a side elevation thereof; and Fig. 3 is a cross-section on line 3—3 Fig. 1.
