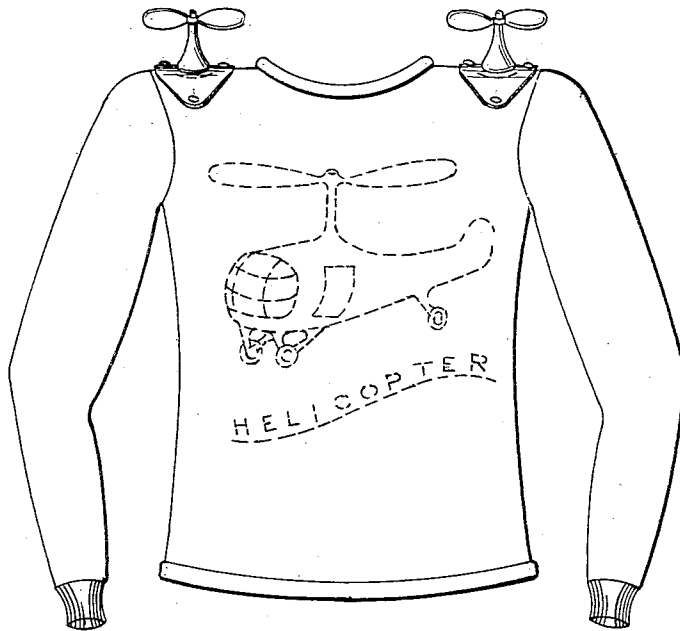
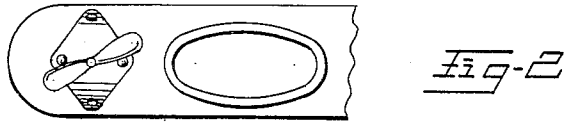

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, W. Vincent Thelander, a citizen of the United States, residing at Toledo, State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Shirt, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part hereof.
