



To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Joseph R. Corbett, a citizen of the United States, residing at Cincinnati, in the county of Hamilton, State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Ceiling Ventilator for Heating and Air Conditioning, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.
