The ornamental design for lower stop device for an invisible zipper, as shown in the accompanying drawings.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the lower stop device for an invisible zipper in accordance with the embodiment of the claimed design;

FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof;


FIG. 8 is an exploded perspective view thereof;



















