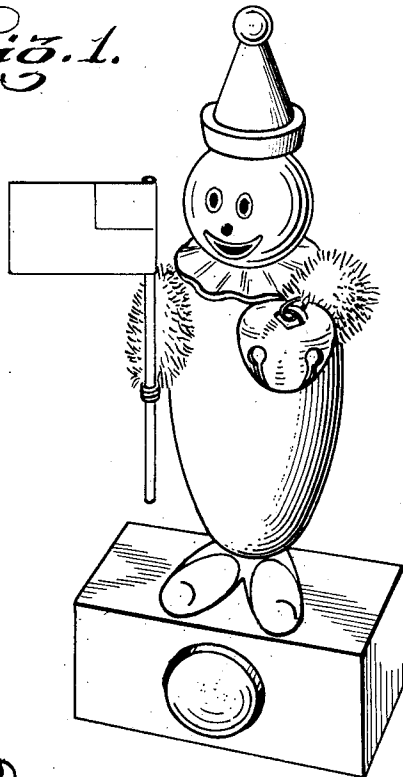

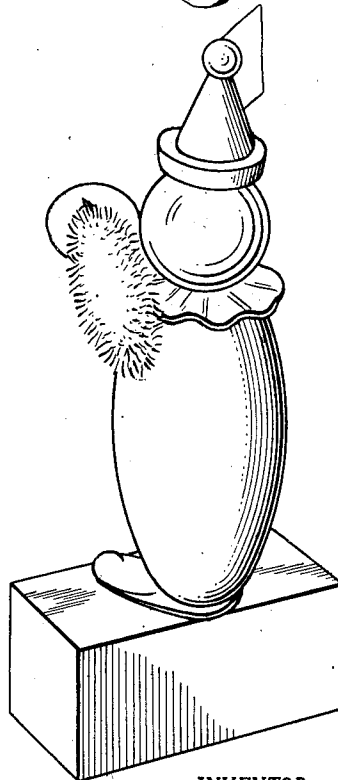
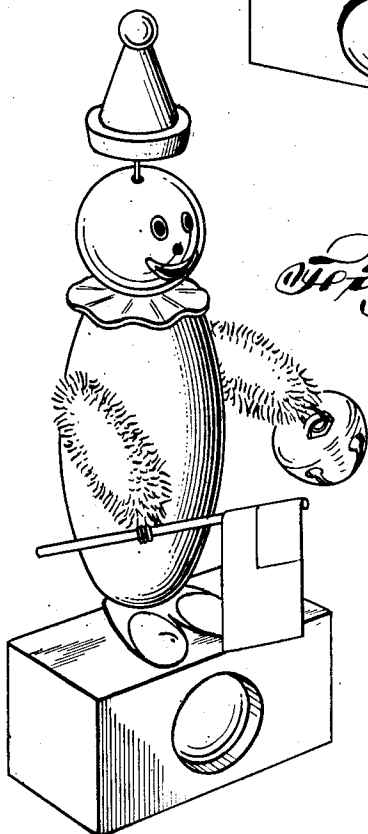

CLOWN FIGURE TOY

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that Calvin Rouse, a citizen of the United States of America and resident of Jamaica, in the State of New York, has invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Clown Figure Toy, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, in which,

Fig. 1 is a front perspective view of a clown figure toy embodying my new design;

Fig. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof; and

Fig. 3 is a front perspective view similar to Fig. 1, but as viewed from the opposite side, and illustrating another position of the parts of the clown figure toy and the button in pressed position in the base.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a clown figure toy, substantially as shown.
