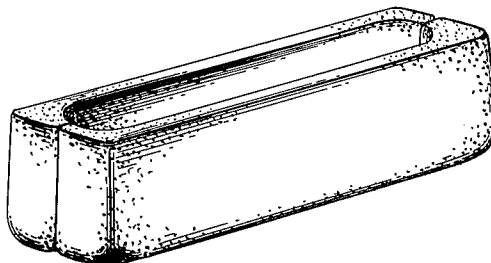
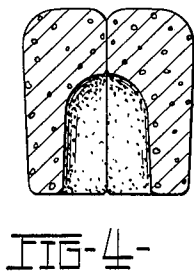
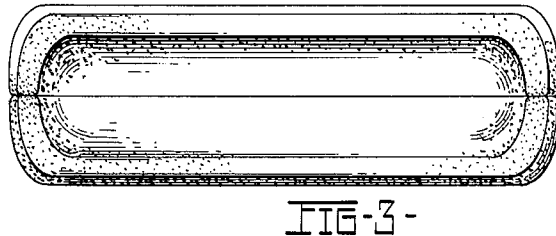
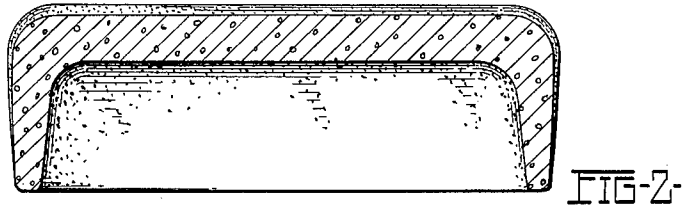
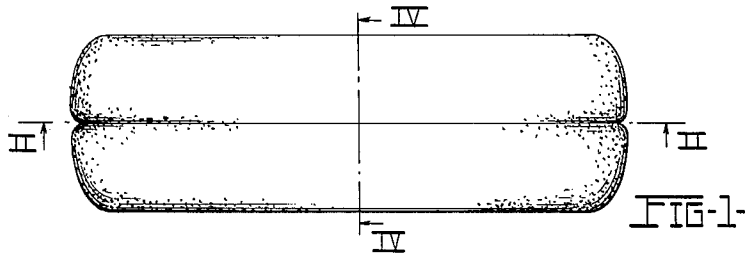

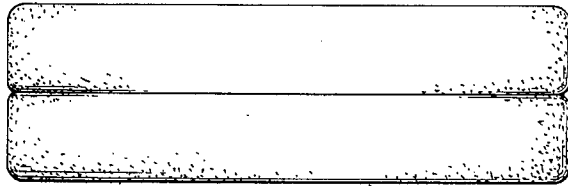

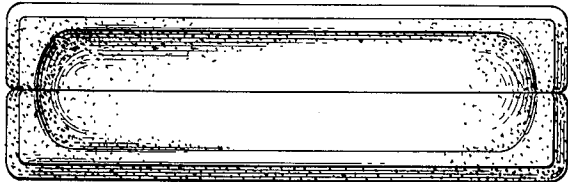

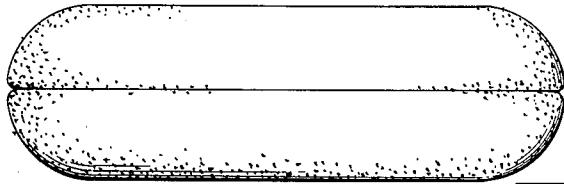

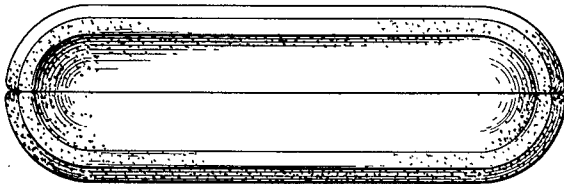

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a hot dog bun incorporating my new design;

FIG. 2 is a sectional view taken on line II—II of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view;

FIG. 4 is a cross-sectional view taken on line IV—IV of FIG. 1; and

FIG. 5 is a bottom perspective view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view of another embodiment of the hot dog bun shown in FIG. 1, wherein the ends have been squared; and

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a plan view of still another embodiment of the hot dog bun shown in FIG. 1, wherein the ends have been more rounded; and

FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view thereof.
