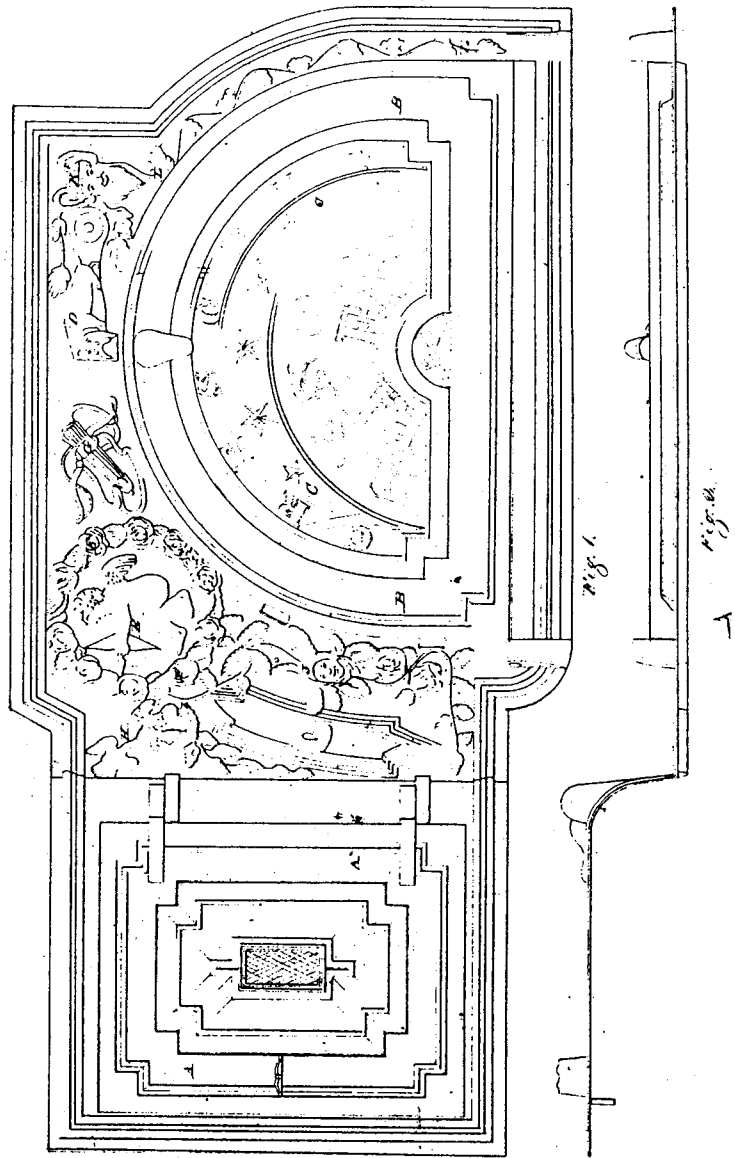

Letters Patent Design No. 134, dated 17th July 1847

The schedule referred to, in these Letters Patent and making part of the same,

To all whom it may concern; Be it known that I William Resor, of the City of Cincinnati in the County of Hamilton and State of Ohio, have invented & produced a new and useful ornamental design for the side plates and doors of Cooking Stoves, to be cast in iron; and I do hereby declare that the following is a full and exact description thereof, as represented in the accompanying drawing.

Fig. 1, is an elevation of the side plate, and fig. 2, an edge view of it, showing its form, or configuration in that

direction. A, is the door of the fire chamber, which is carved in panel work as represented. B, is a semicircular oven ~~door~~ having on it a crescent C, ornamented with stars, and having, in other respects, the form, or configuration as delineated. D, is the latch which serves to fasten the door, and presents the form of head and body of an animal. At E, there is represented a biped with his bow, and surrounded with a wreath of roses F, behind this is a trophy G, containing a bow and quiver, and in front of it two doves. H. There is also a running vine of roses I, I, in part surrounding a female mask J, in rear of the latch D, is a goats head K, from which descends a running vine L, I.

Having thus fully described, and distinctly represented the shape or configuration, and the ornamental design of my side plate and doors for a cooking stove, what I claim as new therein and desire to secure by letters patent, is the particular shape or configuration of the side plate itself having the respective ornaments thereon as represented, I claim also the particular manner of carving and ornamenting the fire door A; I likewise claim the semicircular oven door B having on the ornamental devices as shown; for although it is my intention, in general, to use these parts in combination with each other, it will be manifest that my main pattern of, and the ornamental designs on, the side plate might be used with doors others ornamented.
