

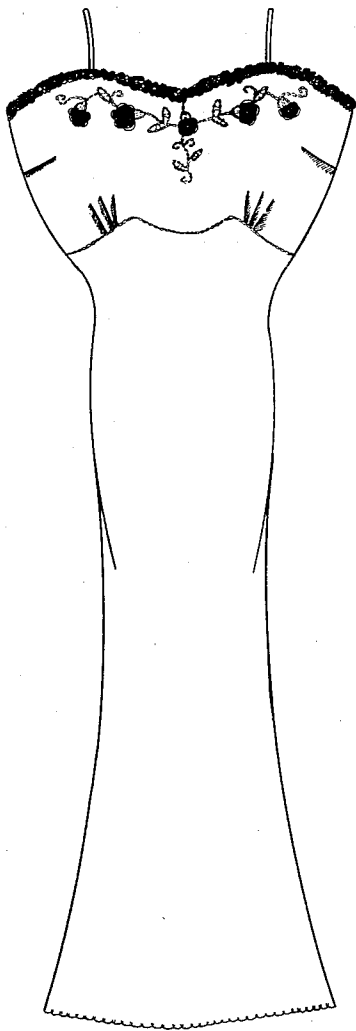

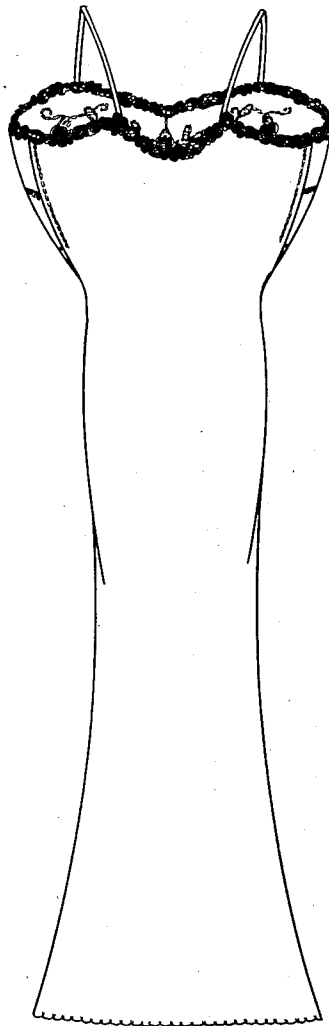

## DESIGN FOR A SLIP

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Harry Cohen, a citizen of the United States of America, residing in the city of New York, county of New York, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Slip, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof,
