DESIGN FOR A WELDING ELECTRODE HOLDER

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Joseph U. Garibay, a citizen of the United States, residing at Montebello, in the county of Los Angeles, State of California, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Welding Electrode Holder, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, in which:

Fig. 1 is a top plan view of a welding electrode holder, showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a side elevation of the same in open position for receiving a rod of welding material;

Fig. 3 is a bottom plan view;

Fig. 4 is a front end view; and

Fig. 5 is a rear end view.
