## DESIGN FOR A BUST.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 16,632, dated April 20, 1886.

Application filed March 11, 1886. Serial No. 194,900. Term of patent 3½ years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, BERNARD DREYFUSS, a citizen of the United States, residing at the city of New York, in the county and State of New York, have invented and produced a new and original Design for a Bust, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The drawing is a front or nearly front view of my newly-designed bust, and which is intended to represent the Irish member of the British Parliament, Mr. Parnell, so widely known as the advocate of home rule for Ireland. The bust is shown with the head uncovered, and as clothed with the upper part of a coat and vest. The bust is mounted on a pedestal, which is provided with sufficient space for a name or inscription. On this pedestal may be placed a name or other words, or both—as, for instance, "Parnell," "Home Rule"—and these may be in raised or other style of letters. The extreme bottom portion, *a*,

of the base or pedestal is octagonal. The portion, *b*, immediately above it is circular, but of <sup>25</sup> lesser diameter. The portion, *c*, next above this has somewhat the form of the Grecian ovolo or echinus inverted or reversed, and still further reducing the diameter or size, and next above this it is a flat annulus, *d*. <sup>30</sup>

The particular details of the moldings of the pedestal may be varied at pleasure, the essential feature of the design being the figure or representation of a bust of Mr. Parnell.

I claim—

1. The design for a bust herein shown and described, consisting of the representation of the head and clothed bust of Parnell.
2. The design for a bust and its pedestal herein shown and described, consisting of the <sup>40</sup> head and clothed bust of Parnell and a supporting pedestal for the same.
