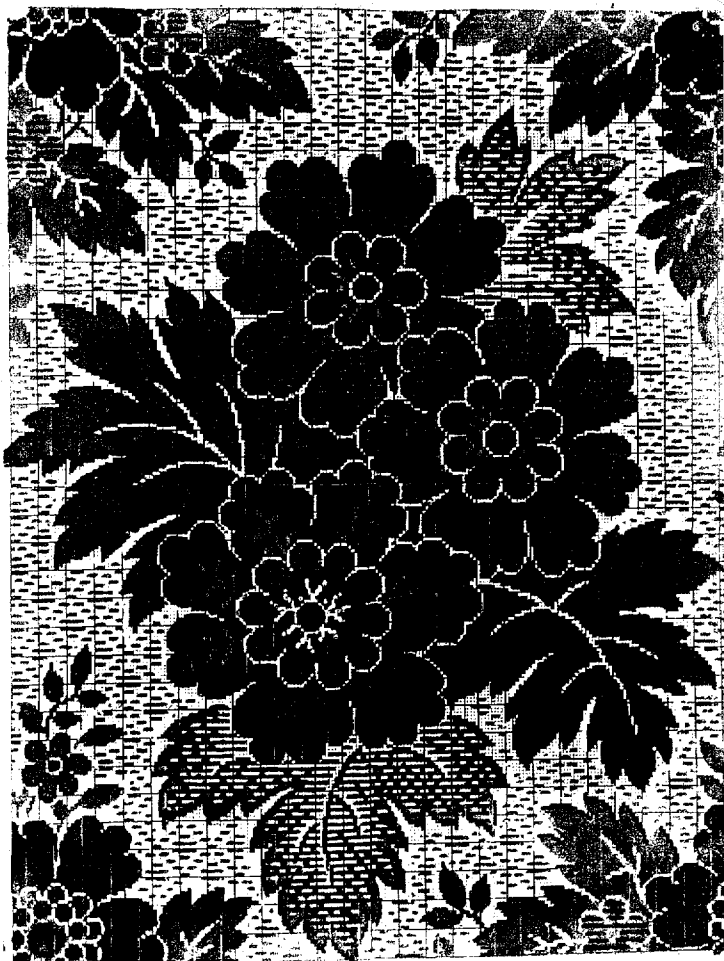

DESIGN FOR A CARPET.

Application filed January 18, 1888. Serial No. 261,170. Term of patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.

To all whom it may concern:

5 a new and original Design for a Pattern to be
Inwrought into Ingrain and other Carpeting;

10 art of carpet-weaving a defined and thorough
description of my invention, that is sufficient

to enable any one skilled in the art of carpet-
weaving to use my invention.
