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LACK OF UNITY OF INVENTION

The Search Division considers that the present European patent application does not comply with the requirements of unity of invention and relates to several inventions or groups of inventions, namely:

1. claims: 1-13

Subject-matter related to a joint prosthesis comprising an adapter dimensioned to be impacted into a depression in an end surface of the prosthetic tray opposite the outer surface of the prosthetic tray thereby forming an interference fit between the adapter and the depression; and a mounting stud having a first end and a second end, the first end being dimensioned for impactation into a socket in the adapter thereby forming an interference fit between the first end and the socket, the second end being dimensioned for insertion into an opening in the implant.

2. claims: 14, 15

Subject-matter related to a device for determining inclination, offset or version of an implant comprising a body having a well; and a joint element having a first end and a second end, the first end being positioned in the well, the second end being movable between positions wherein a longitudinal axis of the second end is angled with respect to an axis of the body and method of using the device comprising (a) providing a trial device including (i) a body having a well, and (ii) a joint element having a first end and a second end, the first end being positioned in the well, the second end being movable between positions wherein a longitudinal axis of the second end is angled with respect to an axis of the body; (b) inserting the second end of the joint element in an opening in the implant; (c) immobilizing the joint element with respect to the body; and (d) securing a mounting stud to the prosthetic tray in a fixed position with respect to the prosthetic tray so as to match an orientation of the immobilized joint element with respect to the body
