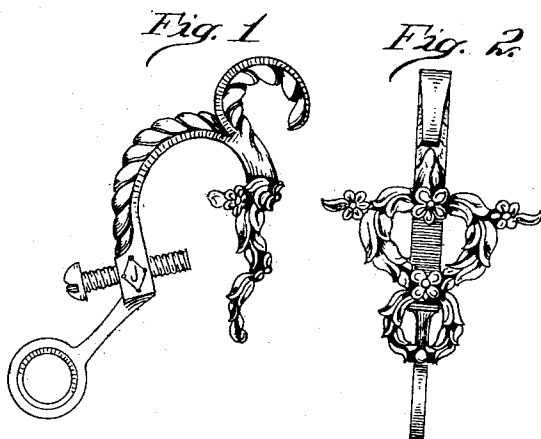

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, CHARLES ERNEST JONES, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Clamp for Light-Reflecting Bowls, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof, wherein—

Figure 1 is a side elevation of a clamp for light reflecting bowls, and

Fig. 2 is a front elevation of the same showing my new design.
