

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a chair frame, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the chair frame showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the chair frame (the opposite side being a mirror image thereof);
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the chair frame; and
FIG. 4 is a plan view of the chair frame;
FIG. 5 is a perspective view of an alternate embodiment of the chair frame.












