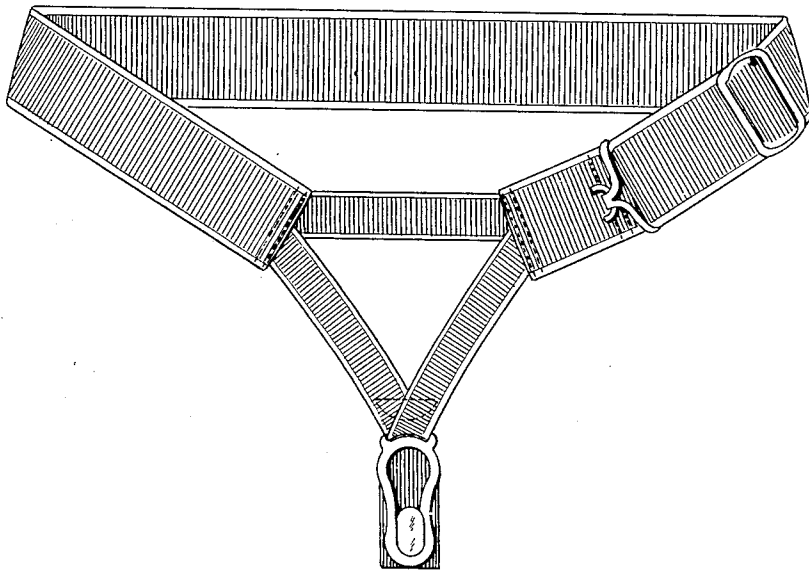

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, GEORGE B. GLIDDEN, a citizen of the United States, residing in Dighton, in the county of Bristol and State of Massachusetts, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Garters, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The drawing is a perspective view of a garter showing my design.

The leg-band is formed of relatively wide webbing and the clasp-suspending device of relatively narrow webbing, and each web-

bing has a broad stripe bounded on opposite edges by narrow stripes. The clasp for the stocking, the catch for the leg-band, and the slide for the adjustment of the leg-band are not new with me.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a garter substantially as shown and described.
