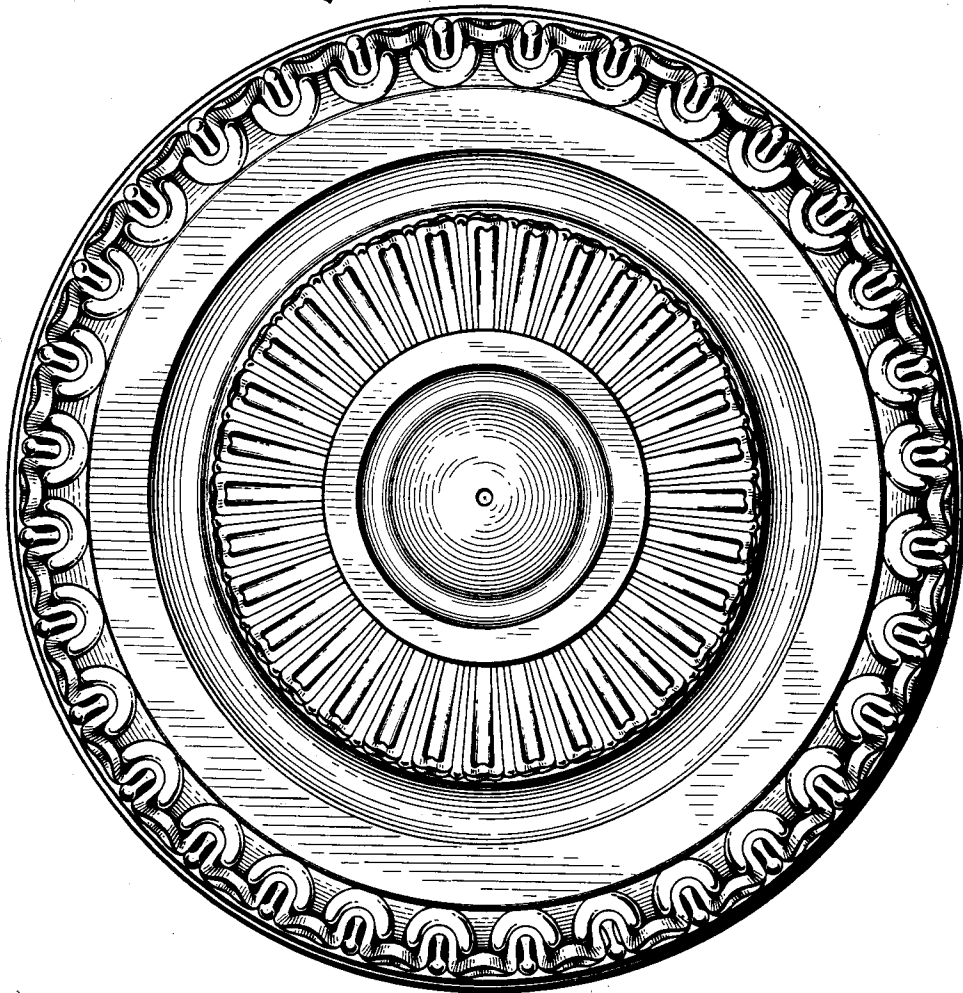

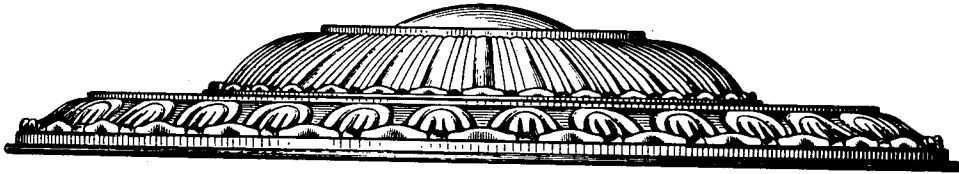

Be it known that I, LAURITZ W. ANDERSEN, a citizen of the United States, residing at Waterbury, in the county of New Haven and State of Connecticut, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Ceiling and Shower Plate, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
