(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a framed transparent panel with central mirror portion, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a framed transparent panel with central mirror portion showing the new design;


FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the framed transparent panel with central mirror portion showing the new design of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view of the framed transparent panel with central mirror portion showing the new design of FIG. 1, the top plan view and the right and left side views being mirror images thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of the framed transparent panel with central mirror portion showing the new design of FIG. 1, as shown, hung on a diagonal; and,

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the framed transparent panel with central mirror portion showing the new design of FIG. 1, as shown, hung on a diagonal as in FIG. 4, the top plan view and the right and left side views being mirror images thereof.








