## DESIGN FOR A MEDAL.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, RALPH C. THOMPSON, a citizen of the United States, residing in the town of Attleboro, in the county of Bristol and State of Massachusetts, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Medal, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a plan view of the obverse side

of a medal illustrating my design. Fig. 2 is a plan view of the reverse side of a medal illustrating my design.
