

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Linus E. Russell, a citizen of the United States, residing at Springfield, Clark County, Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Reflector Unit for Exhaust Pipe Shroud or the like, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof, in which—

Fig. 1 is a perspective view of a reflector unit for an exhaust pipe shroud or the like embodying my new design.

Fig. 2 is a top plan view of the reflector unit.

Fig. 3 is an end elevational view, and

Fig. 4 is a side elevational view thereof.

The exhaust pipe shroud represented by broken lines in the drawing is of conventional appearance and is included for purposes of illustration only.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a reflector unit for an exhaust pipe shroud or the like, substantially as shown.
