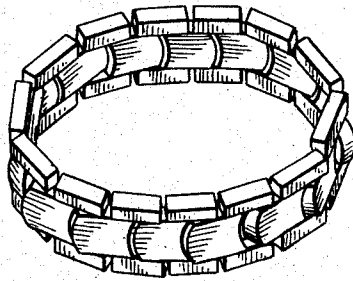

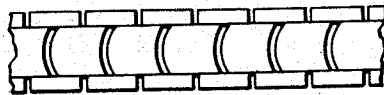
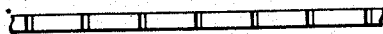

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Michael Chernow, a citizen of the United States, and residing at New York, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Bracelet or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, and in which

Fig. 1 is a perspective view of the bracelet, showing my new design,

Fig. 2 is a fragmentary front elevation of a portion of the bracelet, and

Fig. 3 is a fragmentary side elevational view of the portion shown in Fig. 2.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a bracelet or similar article, substantially as shown.
