

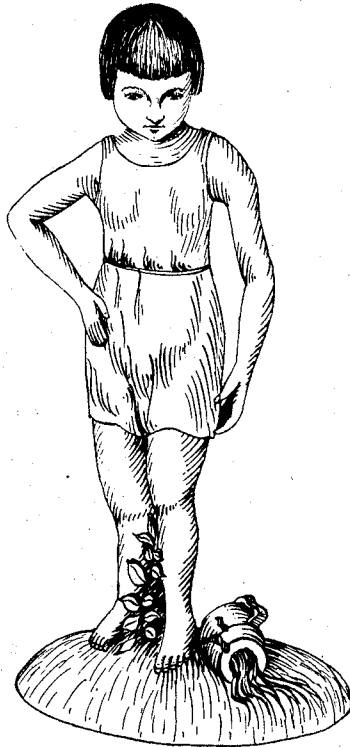

DESIGN FOR A LAMP BASE OR ANALOGOUS ARTICLE.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, PHILIP SILBERHARTZ, a citizen of the United States of America, and a resident of City of Brooklyn, county of Kings and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Lamp Base or Analogous Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part hereof.

The single figure of the drawing shows a perspective view of the lamp base or analogous article.
