



DESIGN FOR A COAT LINING

Louis A. Siegel, Mount Vernon, N. Y.

Application May 13, 1941, Serial No. 100,921

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Louis A. Siegel, a citizen of the United States and a resident of the town of Mt. Vernon, county of Westchester, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Coat Lining, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a front elevational view of a coat lining showing my new design; and

Figure 2 is a rear elevational view of the same.

The characteristic feature of my design resides in the interposition, between the body portion and sleeves of the coat lining, of material of contrasting texture and of the configuration disclosed.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a coat lining, as shown and described.
