FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof;

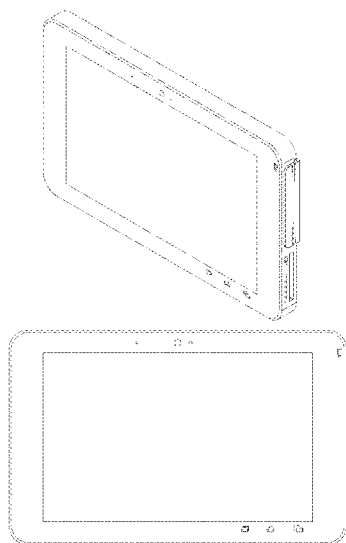
FIG. 8 is a perspective view thereof, shown in use with a magnetic card; and,

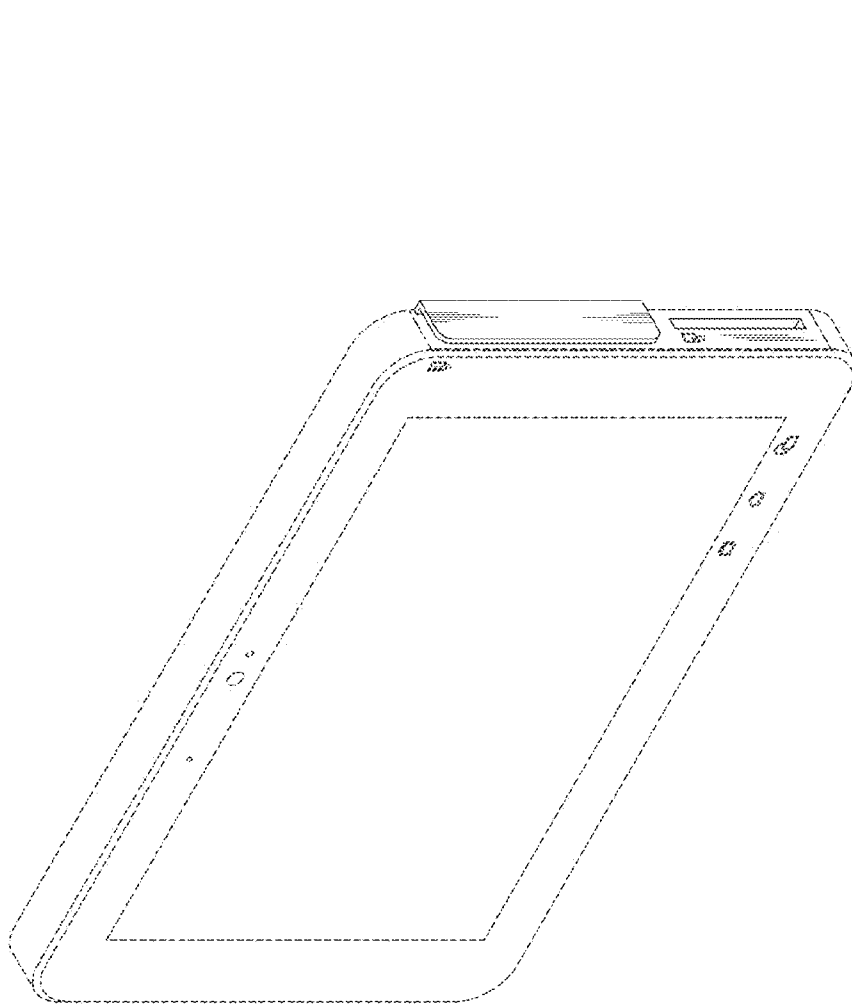

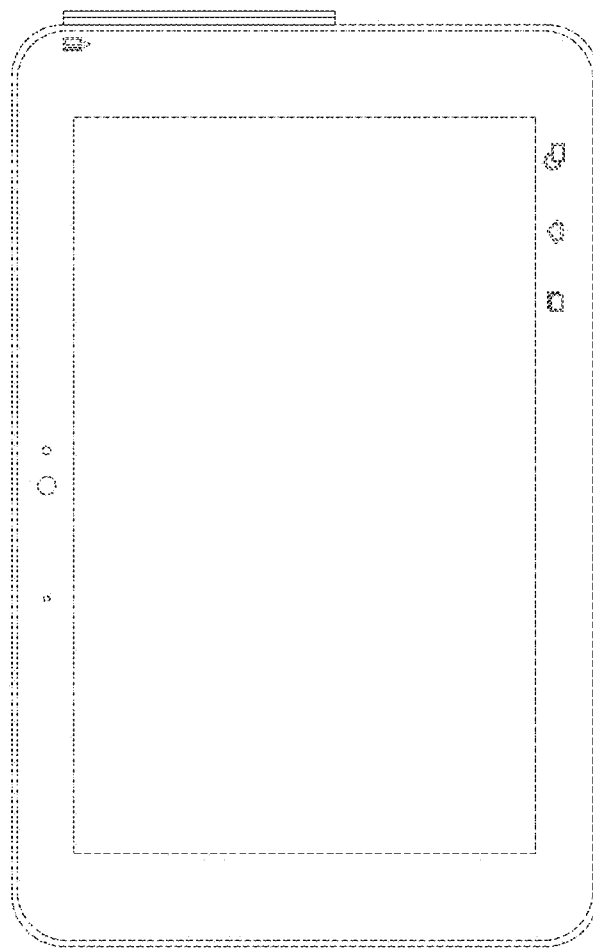

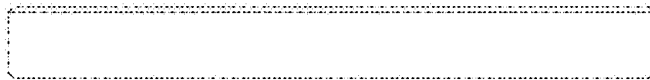

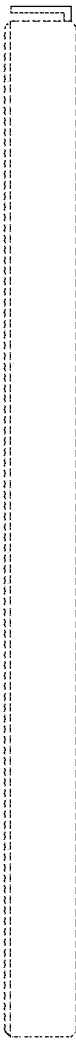

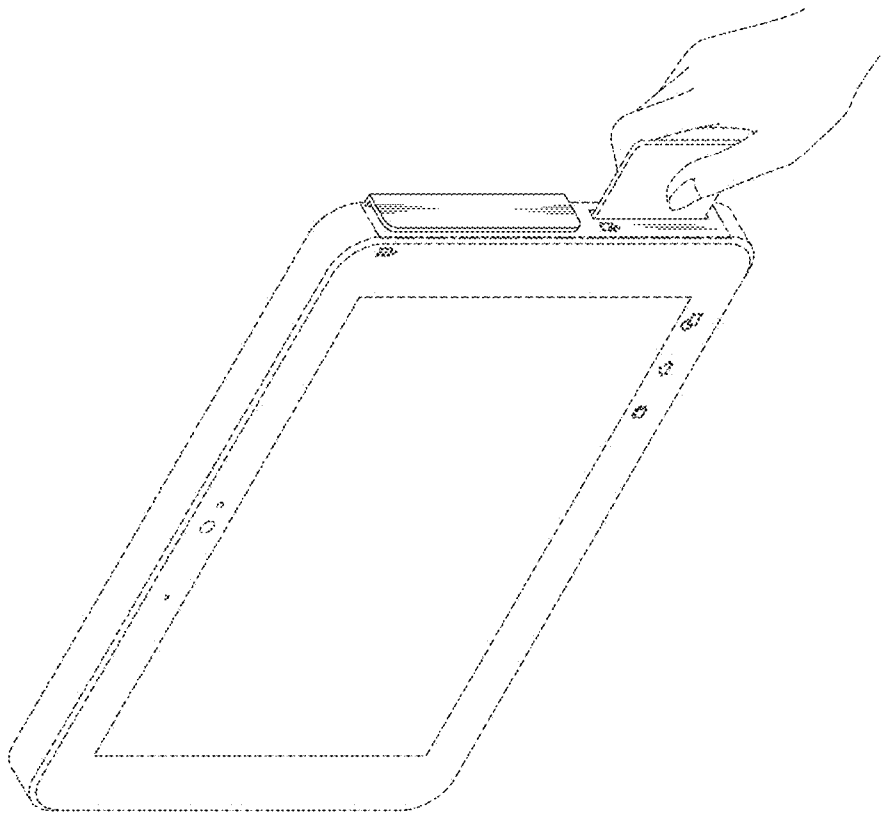

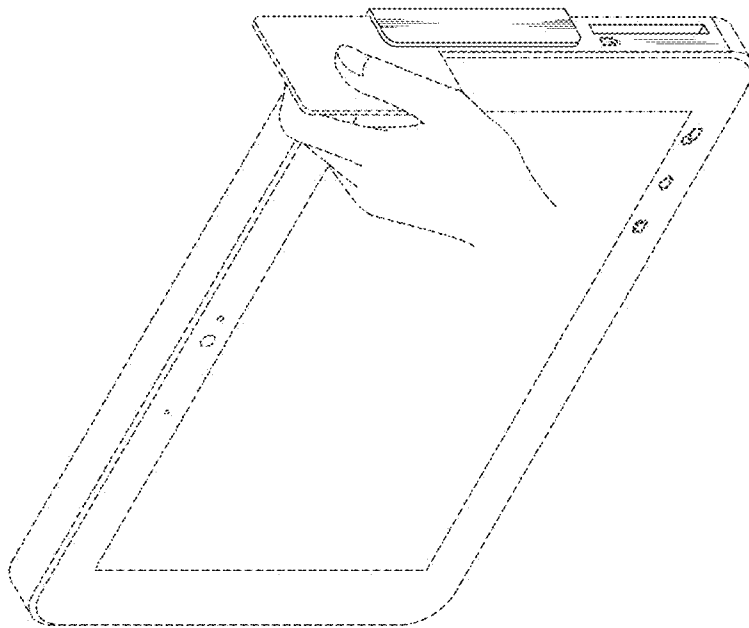
