








*Fig. 3**Fig. 4**Fig. 6**Fig. 5**Fig. 7*

FIG. 5 is a side elevation thereof on a reduced scale as seen from the opposite direction of FIG. 4;

FIG. 6 is a front elevation thereof on a reduced scale; and

FIG. 7 is a rear elevation thereof on a reduced scale.
