## DESIGN FOR AN ALPHABET.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 26,428, dated December 22, 1896.

Application filed July 23, 1896. Serial No. 600,308. Term of patent 14 years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, DANIEL MCFARLAN MOORE, a citizen of the United States, and a resident of Newark, in the county of Essex and State of New Jersey, have invented and produced a new and original Design for an Alphabet, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

My invention relates to a design for an alphabet to be used for decorative and advertising purposes; and it consists in the construction and formation of the characters of said alphabet as herein shown and described.

The drawing illustrates the form of the characters both in outline and in cross-section, sections being taken, for example, through the letter "I" longitudinally and transversely, as indicated at A A and B B, respectively.

All the elements of all the characters, both letters and numbers, are tubular in cross-section,

and the ends of all the tubes are closed, the characters thus formed constituting hollow closed receptacles.

It will be noticed that each character has projecting therefrom rearwardly two or more teats *c c*, as seen in section at A A and indicated by dotted circles at the top and bottom of each letter and numeral. It will also be noticed that in each letter or numeral there is free communication from all parts thereof to the upper and lower teats.

I claim as my invention—

The design for an alphabet herein shown and described.
