#### (57)**CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a belt binder, as shown and described.

## DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view illustrating the interior of the binder when the cover is fully open;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view looking at the spine of the binder when the cover is closed;

FIG. 3 is a perspective view from the opposite side of the binder as the view of FIG. 2, showing the binder when the

FIG. 4 is another view of the interior of the binder when the cover is open, as illustrated in FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 5 is a view of the exterior of the binder when the cover
